There are almost 160 study programmes at all levels (bachelor, master, and Ph.D.) entirely or partially taught in English. All study programmes are of high quality and accredited by the National Entity for Accreditation and Quality Assurance in Higher Education of Serbia. ## AFFORDABLE LIVING COSTS

The average monthly living expenses in Serbia are estimated to be between 300 and 600 EUR (tuition fees not included), depending on the housing type (student dormitories or privately rented accommodation) and the city in Serbia. These amounts are comparatively lower than in other European countries and should be sufficient to cover food, accommodation, utilities, transportation, and miscellaneous expenses.

## ...higher education in Serbia - Key facts

Types of studies: Academic and applied

Serbia belongs to the European Higher Education Area (EHEA): Serbia joined the Bologna Process in 2003 – European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), three levels of studies and issuance of a diploma supplement

Academic studies: Bachelor – lasting 3 or 4 years and carrying 180 or 240 ECTS  
Master – lasting usually 1 or 2 years and carrying 60 or 120 ECTS  
PhD – lasting 3 years and carrying 180 ECTS  
Specialist studies – lasting 1 year and carrying 60 ECTS  
Integrated (Bachelor + Master) – lasting 5 years and carrying 300 ECTS (pharmacy/dentistry) or 6 years and 360 ECTS (medical sciences)

Accreditation: Both the institution and the study programme must be accredited by the national accreditation body

Academic year: Starts in October, lasts two semesters, 60 ECTS credits per annum, usually 5 exam periods

Recognition of degrees: To enrol in Bachelor/Integrated studies – contact the ENIC-NARIC Centre for recognition of your high-school diploma  
To enrol in Master/PhD studies – contact the relevant university

Tuition fees: Usually range from 1000 to 7000 EUR per year, depending on a programme

Living costs: Comparatively lower than in many other European countries  
Accommodation – 60–450 EUR/month  
Food – around 100–150 EUR/month  
Public transportation – around 10–15 EUR/month

Institutions: Universities, faculties/academies of arts (members of universities), Academy of applied studies, colleges (members of academies)

Number of students: 250,000+ students

Number of foreign students: 10,000+ students

## INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNISED QUALITY OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN SERBIA

The most prestigious university rankings in the world feature Serbian universities. On the prestigious 2021 Shanghai Ranking, the University of Belgrade ranked between 501st and 600th place ([shanghairanking.com](http://shanghairanking.com)). The University of Belgrade continues to keep its leading position in the country and the region.

The University Ranking by Academic Performance ([urapcenter.org](http://urapcenter.org)) rated 2500 world's best universities based on academic quality. The most recent list for 2020/2021 included four Serbian universities. The University of Belgrade is in the top 300, and the University of Novi Sad is among the 900 best world universities. The Universities of Nis and Kragujevac ranked among 1500 world's best higher education institutions.

The CWTS Leiden Ranking 2021 ([leidenranking.com](http://leidenranking.com)) also offers important insights into the scientific performance of over 1200 major universities worldwide. The University of Belgrade is rated as the 52nd best university in Europe and the 193rd university in the world. Being rated at the 228th place, the University of Novi Sad is another Serbian university highly ranked in Europe.



## EXCELLENCE IN SUBJECT FIELDS

If you have a specific study interest, there is a chance that Serbian universities have you covered! The University of Belgrade is in the top 75 best universities in the world in Food Science and Technology, according to the [2021 subject rankings published by the Shanghai Ranking Consultancy](#). Furthermore, the University of Novi Sad ranked between 201st and 300th place in the same subject. Moreover, the University of Belgrade ranked among the 300 best world universities across several study fields of Medical and Life Sciences. Besides the University of Belgrade, the University of Kragujevac is in the top 300 world's universities in Clinical Medicine.

Covering more than 50 different subjects, URAP's subject rankings put the University of Belgrade in the 76th place of the world's best universities in Food Engineering. The University of Novi Sad is in the top 250 in the same field. Also, the University of Belgrade ranked among the 200 best universities in many other fields, such as Metallurgy Engineering, Pharmacology, Dentistry, Zoology, Transportation Science and Technology.

## Tuition fees

Tuition fees in Serbia are paid per year and usually range from 1000 EUR to 7000 EUR. Tuition fees normally cover 60 credits (ECTS) per annum and include access to university/college facilities, such as computer labs, libraries, and other study services. Books and study materials are usually not included; however, their price rarely exceeds 100-250 EUR per year.

## Cost of accommodation

Student dormitories: Prices vary depending on the number of persons sharing a room. Usually, a monthly rate for a double room is around 100 EUR per person, with all utilities included.

Housing: The cost of privately rented accommodation depends on the location, size, position, and state of the rented flat. Sharing a flat with other students in a small town can cost from 60 EUR (plus around 30 EUR for utilities) per person. If you want to rent a whole apartment in a central location in Belgrade for yourself, that can require up to 300 EUR monthly, plus 150 EUR for utilities.

## Food expenses

Students restaurants in Serbia offer meals at discounted prices - around 1-1.5 EUR per meal. Those restaurants are open to all students who own a student card. Groceries are cheaper in supermarkets than in smaller local shops, and fruits and vegetables are the cheapest (and of better quality) when bought at the farmers' markets.

## Travel costs


A monthly pass with student discount is around 10 EUR or less.

The monthly pass is valid for an unlimited number of journeys on all means of public transport.

## Cost of leisure activities

- Coffee or soft drink in a café ~ 1 EU
- Cinema ticket (unlike in many other European countries, in Serbia you can watch blockbusters in English since movies are not dubbed) ~ 2-5 EUR
- A night out ~ 15 EUR
- One-day excursion (to a historical or natural landmark, shopping tour, etc.) ~ 10-20 EUR

#### Where?

Higher education institutions are located all over the country, but the biggest university centres with the largest student population are Belgrade (the capital), Novi Sad, Niš, and Kragujevac.

#### What?

With over 140 full-degree study programs at all levels entirely or partially taught in English and many other programmes available to visiting exchange students, Serbia offers many opportunities for prospective foreign students.

#### In which language?

The main language of instruction is Serbian, however, there are also study programmes entirely or partially taught in English and other foreign languages.

#### How much does it cost?

The cost of studying and living in Serbia is considerably lower than in other European countries. Tuition fees range from 1000 EUR to 7000 EUR, living costs (accommodation, food and other expenses) are around 350-400 EUR monthly. Fun and leisure activities are also very affordable.

#### When?

Although application deadlines vary, most fall in June (for undergraduate studies) and October (for master and PhD degrees). We understand that sometimes it can be challenging to navigate through the application process. 

The programmes are presented by fields of study and divided into the following three categories:

### **PROGRAMMES IN BLUE**

are entirely taught in English. All lectures and other student services will be provided in English to foreign students.



### **PROGRAMMES IN RED**

are not just entirely taught in English, but the higher education institutions providing the programmes have a long tradition of welcoming international students.

### **PROGRAMMES IN GREY**

are partially taught in English, therefore, the institutions offering the programmes do not guarantee that all lectures will be offered solely in English. Instead, some classes might be offered in Serbian; however, additional support and services (such as individual sessions and consultations with teaching staff) will be provided to foreign students.

# Learn...

Currently, there are almost 160 study programmes at all educational levels accredited in English which are listed in this publication.

These are not the only programmes accredited in foreign languages. There are programmes accredited in English and Serbian that might not be fully available in foreign languages in this academic year. Though lectures and group activities may be organised mostly in Serbian, additional opportunities for foreign students are offered, such as consultations with teaching staff in English or other foreign languages. These programmes are especially suitable for shorter student mobilities through Erasmus+ or other mobility programmes.

You can find these programmes in the StudyInSerbia.rs database of learning opportunities for foreign students.

Centers of Serbian as a foreign language offer Serbian language courses in Belgrade, Novi Sad, Niš, and Kragujevac.







- If you are interested in a study programme featured in this publication, contact the higher education institution that offers the programme if you have questions. Contact information can be found on the list of study programmes. If you are interested in any other programme, look for it in the StudyinSerbia.rs database or on the institution's website and find contact information. You can also email us at [study-inserbia@tempus.ac.rs](mailto:study-inserbia@tempus.ac.rs) if you need any help at this step.

**Prepare necessary documents and apply**

- Application documents usually include a completed application form, a copy of passport/ID, transcripts of records and/or proof of acquired academic qualifications, proof of application fee payment, etc. Check with the chosen institution which documents you would need to submit. Some documents may require a certified translation. At this stage, you can usually submit the documents electronically or by post.

**Get your diploma(s) recognized**

- If you are interested in bachelor studies, your high school diploma should be recognized by the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development ([http://azk.gov.rs/?page\\_id=75148](http://azk.gov.rs/?page_id=75148)) before you enroll in a study programme.
- If you are continuing your studies in Serbia, contact the chosen institution (university or academy) to start the recognition process of your previous degrees. This process can be lengthy, so contact the relevant institutions well in advance.

**Take and pass an entrance exam**

- To be eligible to enrol in a university or college, you would probably need to take and pass an entrance exam. Entrance exams are usually organized in June for undergraduate and in September-October for postgraduate studies. There is no one universal test that all candidates need to take, entrance exams differ from programme to programme.

### Formally enrol and pay the tuition fee

- To complete your enrolment process, you would need to submit proof of tuition fee payment, along with other documents, such as the certificate that states that your previously earned degree(s) is acceptable (recognised) in Serbia. You may be also asked to submit additional documents.
- The tuition fees should normally be paid in full, but some institutions offer the possibility of paying in instalments.

### Apply for a visa

Since you will probably need to come to Serbia to take an entrance exam, make sure to check whether you need a visa to enter Serbia at <https://www.studyinserbia.rs/en/living-in-serbia/visa-and-permits>. If you do, fill in the visa application form and submit it to the nearest Serbian embassy or consulate along with the rest of the required documents. Once you get accepted to a university/faculty, you should receive a conditional letter of acceptance. Use that letter to apply for a type D (long-term visa). If you are granted a type D visa, you will be able to apply for a residence permit after you arrive in Serbia.

### Find accommodation

Foreign students can opt for accommodation in student dormitories, or they can rent an entire apartment for themselves or share it with other students. Student dormitories are available in cities with a larger student population. Staying in a student dorm is more budget-friendly than renting a whole apartment. Look for accommodation in advance and contact the International Office at your university/faculty to check if they can assist you in finding a place to stay.

### Apply for a temporary residence permit

# Learn...

Did you know that there is a possibility of going on a student exchange to another European country while studying in Serbia? Being part of student exchange programmes, such as Erasmus+ and CEEPUS, Serbian higher education institutions offer various opportunities for participating in a student exchange abroad or undertaking a traineeship in another European country.

## ERASMUS+ AT A GLANCE



## Erasmus+

Erasmus+ is an EU-funded programme for education, training, youth, and sport for 2014-2020. The programme offers the possibility of spending a study period abroad to students who completed a minimum of two semesters of studies. Erasmus+ also allows students to undertake a traineeship in a company, enterprise or another relevant workplace at any time during their studies. Erasmus exchange students are exempt from paying tuition fees for their studies and traineeships, and there are some grants available to help with living costs.

The Foundation Tempus is the National Agency responsible for the Erasmus+ programme in Serbia. For more information on the Erasmus+ mobility opportunities, visit the website <https://erasmus-plus.rs/home-eng/>



## HOW TO APPLY?

Applications are usually submitted through your home university's Erasmus or international office. To apply for this programme, contact your home institution to receive more information about exchange possibilities.

## MOBILITY TYPES

1. Student exchanges: a study abroad experience that can accumulate credit towards the qualification a student is undertaking in his/her home university. Student exchanges can last from three to twelve months.
2. Traineeships: a work placement abroad intended to upgrade professional skills. Traineeships cannot be shorter than two months or longer than one year.

## WHO CAN APPLY?

To be eligible:

1. You have to be enrolled in a higher education institution that is part of the Erasmus+ programme.
2. For student exchanges only, you have to be a second-year student.

## CEEPUS IN A NUTSHELL



CEEPUS is an exchange academic program that is being carried out in 15 Central-European countries. The programme offers short-term and long-term mobility opportunities to students and allows them to spend a study period abroad (long-term mobility) or conduct research for a master's thesis or doctoral dissertation at another partner higher education institution (short-term mobility). CEEPUS is based on university networks comprising at least three higher education institutions (or their faculties and departments) from the CEEPUS countries. There are two types of mobility: mobility inside CEEPUS networks (network mobility) and mobility outside CEEPUS networks (free movers). CEEPUS mobility grants include a paid tuition and a monthly remuneration. Depending on the country, students can also be entitled to free accommodation and discounted meals. ## ...exchange programmes

### MOBILITY TYPES

1. Short-term student: last a maximum of 3 months, intended for undertaking research for a master's thesis or a doctoral dissertation
2. Long-term student: a minimum of 3 months, maximum 2 academic semesters, enables students to spend part of their studies at another higher education institution in one of the participating countries (15 Central-European countries)

### HOW TO APPLY?

Applications have to be submitted online, through the CEEPUS official website. The application deadline for the summer semester is October 15 and for the winter semester is June 15. Freemovers can apply until November 30.

Contact your home institution in Serbia to check whether it participates in the CEEPUS programme. ### WHO CAN APPLY?

To be eligible:

1. You have to be a student at a higher education institution in a CEEPUS country who completed at least 2 semesters of studies.
2. To be a citizen of a CEEPUS member state. Foreign students who do not have the citizenship of a CEEPUS member state are also allowed to apply, however, they would need to submit an "equal status document" (residence card or visa).

The north of the country is covered in golden-green grain fields which are intersected with many rivers and small lakes. The central and southern parts are predominantly mountainous and also rich in rivers and lakes. The western area of Serbia is dominated by hills and covered in forests. It is known for its fruit production.

## BELGRADE *Beograd*

The White city, the capital of the country, is located on the confluence of the Danube and Sava rivers. Conveniently situated on the crossroads of main Balkan routes, the city has seen many who tried to conquer it through history, however, in the end, Belgrade conquers its visitors with its unique spirit and charm.



## Novi Sad

The city of Novi Sad is the administrative centre of the northern province of Vojvodina, and it is located 90 kilometers northwest of the capital. It is globally known for one of the best music festivals in the world—Exit—and it was also the 2019 European Youth Capital. In 2021 the city of Novi Sad will be the European Capital of Culture.



## Niš

Globally known as the birthplace of one of the most eminent Roman emperors - Constantine the Great, the city of Niš is one of the oldest in the Balkans. Located in the southern part of Serbia, Niš is a large university centre and the administrative centre of the Nišava district.



## Kragujevac

The very first capital of modern Serbia, the city of Kragujevac, is home to one of the first democratic constitutions in the world that was adopted in the early 19th century. It is also a well-known university centre and the fourth largest city in the Republic of Serbia.



The beauty of Serbia can also be appreciated in its numerous small towns. Sremski Karlovci, a town in the province of Vojvodina, has a long scholarly tradition. Some of the first schools in the Serbian language were founded in Sremski Karlovci. This is also the place where a future university centre for foreign students is going to be established.

## Housing options

Student dormitories and restaurants are available in all university cities. Student dormitories offer accommodation in shared rooms at affordable prices. Dormitories are well-equipped with the necessary amenities and offer various services to students, from dining to cleaning. Student restaurants provide meals at discounted prices to all students who hold a student card. Check with your higher education institution how to apply for student accommodation and how to get a student card.



## Student City in Belgrade

Belgrade's biggest student residence Studentski grad (Student City) is one of the largest in the Balkans, with over 4000 places available. Student City comprises eight dorms, one big student restaurant, a library with spacious reading and studying rooms, a small theatre and cinema hall, a gallery, a café, a summer stage, a gym and outdoor sports courts, a disco, a polyclinic, and a post office. A great number of plays, concerts, literary evenings and other social and cultural events take place on-site, so students can take part in different leisure activities, meet their peers and have fun. # Useful information

## Travelling in/to Serbia

You can reach Serbia by air, train, car or bus, depending on where you are located.



- 2 airports: Nikola Tesla Belgrade (BEG) and Constantine the Great Niš (INI)
- Bus stations in every city/town: Buses are the cheapest and most reliable means for getting around the country.
- Train stations in big cities and cities/towns between them: Traveling by train is usually more budget-friendly, however, trains are not as reliable as buses.
- Good highway networks: Serbia is located on the Pan-European Corridor 10, the shortest route between Central/Western and Southern Europe. You can drive your car in Serbia, just make sure that your vehicle is insured and registered and that your driver's license is up to date.



## Currency

The official currency of Serbia is the Serbian dinar (abbreviated RSD). You can receive around 118 dinars for 1 euro (March 2020).

Cash and debit and credit cards are widely accepted. A great number of ATMs is available 24/7. Banks also perform currency exchange, but almost always at less favourable exchange rates than official exchange offices, which are numerous in both bigger and smaller cities.

## Health Emergency

The Emergency Service is available around the clock and can be reached by dialing 194. You are required to have health insurance during your stay in Serbia.

## Sports and recreation in Serbia

Serbia is a nation of athletes. The most popular sports in Serbia are football, basketball, water polo, tennis, volleyball, etc. A variety of sporting events is organized throughout the year all around Serbia. It is also popular to watch matches on big screens in cafes or restaurants, especially during international sporting competitions, such as the Football World Cup or the Olympics.

### Here are some ways to unwind and have fun after a long day at school

**Join a sports or recreation club** – You can become a member of a local sports club and practise your desired sport a couple of times a week. Monthly membership goes from 10 EUR to 50 EUR, depending on the sport and equipment needed. You can usually ask for one free training session to make sure you want to join the club.

**Join a gym** – Gyms, especially in larger cities, are numerous and easily accessible. Sign up for a monthly membership and exercise at your own pace or receive help from a professional trainer.


**Book a walking tour or go for a hike** – Sign up for walking or hiking tours and explore stunning Serbian landscapes. If you want to discover Serbian cities, there are free walking tours that you can join.

### Have a free evening? Go out!

There is always something going on, especially in the larger university cities.

Big shopping malls are open until 10 PM Monday through Sunday. Most restaurants, bars and cafes usually work until midnight on weekdays and until 1 or 2 AM on weekends. The "splavs" - floating river clubs, and regular clubs are usually open until early morning.

Serbia is a safe country, so you can always enjoy a relaxing walk with friends after long study hours. There are grocery stores and bakeries that work around the clock, so you can also have a late-night snack while wandering around.



## Festivals and concerts

Serbia is a nation of music lovers and many live concerts and festivals are organized throughout the year. Bigger cities, such as Belgrade and Novi Sad, have glorious music venues ideal for major summer shows and festivals, such as EXIT. Smaller cities also host popular regional festivals and musicians.

**Can I work in Serbia while studying?**

Foreign students can work up to 20 hours per week during term-time. Prior to working, they will need to obtain a work permit. Work permits are issued by the National Employment Service. For more information, please consult the EURAXESS webpage - [www.euraxess.rs](http://www.euraxess.rs).



**Are there scholarships for foreign students?**

There are student exchange programmes for short term mobilities (Erasmus+ and CEEPUS). Also, some scholarships may be available through bilateral agreements between Serbia and other countries. **Are there many foreign students in Serbia?**

Serbia has a long tradition of hosting foreign students, especially from Asia, Africa and Europe, but also from other continents. Currently, several thousand foreign students from more than 110 countries are studying in Serbia.



The Ministry is dedicated to further improve the studying opportunities for foreign students. These plans include an initiative to develop a modern centre for foreign students in Sremski Karlovci, a small town in northern Serbia with a long scholarly tradition, in which some of the first Serbian language schools were established in the 18th century.




